## SUMMER STUNT-FEST EXHIBITION CLASS

**1.** Purpose: This event is intended to provide modelers a forum to demonstrate Control Line Models that may not be competitive in existing classes of competition such as scale stunt planes, old timers, sport planes, strange designs, autogyros, or multi-engine models. As an alternative, participant may choose to demonstrate a control line event not offered at stunt contests such as scale, balloon bust, carrier, race, or combat.

- 2. All AMA safety rules will apply.
- 3. Airplane: Must be a control-line model.
  3a. Model must be unique to the Exhibition Class and not be entered in any other event at the 2014 Stunt-Fest competition.

**4**. Engine(s): Any engine up to 15cc/.91 cu.in. is allowed. Electrics are allowed. Due to WDA field regulations, mufflers are mandatory.

**5**. Line sizes, pull tests, and required equipment are to be in accordance with AMA safety guidelines for the respective type and class of model.

**6**. Competition will take place on Sunday during lunch break at the 2014 WDA Summer Stunt fest.

- 7. Pilot does not have to be the builder or owner of the model.
- 8. Operative Details:

7a. Due to time constraints entry will be limited to the first five registrants.

**7b**. A maximum of 10 minutes will be allotted each participant to perform their exhibition.

**7c**. Each exhibition flight will be judged by fellow pilots and contest participants. Voting will be by secret ballot.

7**d**. Judging criteria shall be based on which exhibition flight the individual judge enjoyed viewing the most.

**7e**. Trophy will be awarded to the winning pilot or builder and/or owner if proxy flown.

**7f**. Please notify CD at least two weeks prior to the contest if any special arrangements need to be made to accommodate your exhibition flight.
