June 10, 2019 General Meeting Minutes

Board Members/Officers present: President: Kerry Roberson, Treasurer: John Eaton, Secretary: Mike Frint. Board Members: Doug Barton, Sheldon Berkowitz, Mike O'Kane, Danny Winters. Safety Officer: John Lett. **Ab-sent:** Vice President: Doug Vice, Board Member: Chris Dellinger.

The meeting, held at the Woodland Public Library, was called to order by Kerry Roberson at 1901 hours. The meeting started with twelve members and ended with thirteen. There was one guest.

The meeting started with a short presentation by our guest, Ron Burch, from the Sacramento Valley Historical Railways. www.SVHR.org. SVHR is an organization dedicated to the history of railroading in the Sacramento Valley and in particular, Woodland. For many years they have been restoring the historic train depot in Woodland. SVHR is interested in having WDA possibly putting on a display as like we used to do at the mall.

A motion was made to approve last month's general meeting minutes. The motion was seconded and adopted with only John opposing.

Officer reports:

President: Kerry recognized the contributions of the helicopter event to Autism Speaks. He also talked of his returning to his C-130 project and gave us some details about it.

Vice President: Doug was absent.

Treasurer/Membership: John restated his report from the Board meeting. We have ninety-three members.

Secretary: Mike pointed out that the Channel 40 paddle for 72 megahertz has been missing at the field. If anyone has it please return it.

Safety: John Lett continued the previous conversations about large model aircraft (LMA). John L. and Kerry pointed out some resources on the AMA website for the club to use. Discussion ensued while Jeff L. and Forrest did some online research. John L. is willing to work with members on certifications but don't expect to show up the morning of an event and get signed off. John E. suggest that we make a club policy that we will not do certification sign-offs at events. It was also pointed out that we should be looking for FAA and AMA identification on

members' aircraft. The overflight of the neighbor's house was addressed. John L. met with the neighbor and at this time the neighbor seems to be satisfied.

Chair reports:

Field: Art asked when we will get water from the canal again. John says we are waiting for the power pole and wiring to be installed.

Newsletter: Rich was absent.

Website: Kerry said the website is up to date.

Points: Stein was absent.

Old Business: Water/power/electrical supplies-Kerry asked if any members had questions about the project. There were none. John said we were still waiting for SMUD to show up as the new power pole will be twenty-one feet from gas lines. **LMA-**A little more discussion on LMA, airspace, and the FAA occurred. Kerry suggested that event flyers should state that we won't do LMA certifications during the event.

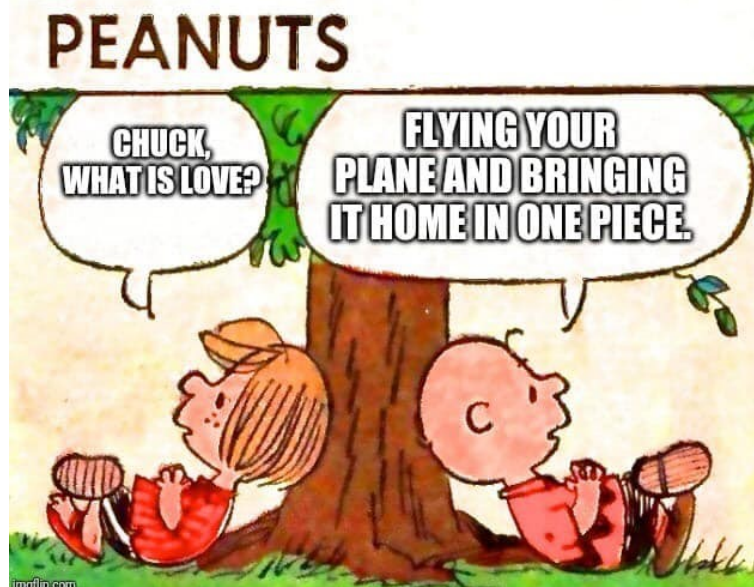

June 10, 2019 Board Meeting Minutes

Board Members/Officers present: President: Kerry Roberson, Treasurer: John Eaton, Secretary: Mike Frint. Board Members: Doug Barton, Sheldon Berkowitz, Mike O'Kane, Danny Winters. Safety Officer: John Lett. **Absent:** Vice President: Doug Vice, Board Member: Chris Dellinger.

The meeting, held at the Woodland Public Library, was called to order by Kerry Roberson at 1807 hours. The meeting started with seven members present and ended with a total of ten. No guests or new members.

A motion was made by Danny W. to approve last month's Board meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Kerry and adopted with only Sheldon abstaining.

Officer Reports:

President: Kerry stated that he had nothing new to report except that he finally got to fly again recently.

Vice President: Doug was absent.

Secretary: Mike mentioned that a gentleman from the Sacramento Valley Historical Railways may be coming to the general meeting tonight.

Old Business: Overflight-A brief review of the possible overflight of the neighbor's house was given to Sheldon as he was unaware. **Water supply/pumps/electrical-**Doug B. stated that we may be "put off for awhile" on this project. SMUD wants to be there when the hole for the new P. G. and E. pole is dug. Kerry stated that Kinder/Morgan has a pipe north of SMUD's to be cautious of. Doug thought the power pole would only be about four and half feet deep anyway. **Shade structure-**Mike O. stated that still he needs to get together with John E. about the design. Doug B. said part of the current structure came apart in the winds.

Field: Doug B. and Bill McGaughey recently planted two trees near the snack shack. The trees were donated.

Treasurer/Membership: John came in late at 1826. Money was spent on field maintenance, tractor maintenance, gasoline, airplane scales, boat trailer repair and field equipment. We also spent money on permits for the electrical project, legal fees and snack shack supplies for the helicopter event. The biggest expense was for the new power pole. Then he immediately continued into more about the water/electrical project. He recommended that

we hand dig the trench otherwise the notifications to other organizations could slow down the project. He stated that we have everything on hand except the water pipe. John reported that we have 93 paid up members now.

More Old Business: Runway centerline marker barrels-Has the north barrel been moved yet? **Memorial Plaque-**John gave the plaque for Milt DeGroot to the secretary to be installed at the field.

Events: No events held since the last meeting. Upcoming -Wings of Victory June 28-30. The trash cans need to be put out and the toilets have been serviced.

New Business: Field Locks-Doug B. reports that people are putting the locks together incorrectly at the end of the day, making the field inaccessible to the users of the other locks. This needs to be noted in the newsletter. John suggests that we add some more links to the chain also. **Publicity Idea-**Mike O. stated that we have had eight helicopter events now and we need to use this as an opportunity to get some publicity for the club.

Meeting adjourned at 1845 hours.

Where? - Gold Country Flyers flying field, lone, CA located on Michigan Bar Road between Hiway 16 and the City of lone.

Note that Michigan Bar Road (aka lone Road) is currently closed. See detour instructions on the back of this flyer.

When? - Starts at 7:00 AM until ?

Food? - Yes, there will be food at a nominal cost.

We will allow flying as soon as it seems safe to fly. All swap meet attendees are welcome to fly at our field that day (**you MUST have an AMA card WITH YOU**).

For all those new and long time attendees of the Gold Country Swap Meet, there is a major change this year. The lone Road (AKA Michigan Bar Road) off of Highway 16 (AKA Jackson Highway) is currently CLOSED due to a bridge replacement. There is a detour available which adds very little time to your journey to our flying field.

First of all, if you normally get to our flying field by driving through the town of lone, or by coming from Highway 99 from the direction of Galt on Highway 104, nothing has changed. You will see many signs about lone Road (AKA Michigan Bar Road) being closed to thru traffic. Just drive round those signs and proceed to the flying field as you always have.

If you are traveling to the swap meet on Highway 16 (AKA Jackson Highway) from Sacramento, Rancho Murrieta or other points West ; or you are traveling to the swap meet on Highway 16 (AKA Jackson Highway) from Plymouth, Placerville or other points East, there is a quick and easy detour.

For those traveling from Rancho Marietta, Sacramento and other points West on Highway 16 (AKA Jackson Highway) will have to detour by driving **past** lone Road approximately 5 miles and **turn right onto Forrest Home Road**.

For those traveling from Placerville, Plymouth and other points East on Highway 16 (AKA Jackson Road) will have to detour by turning approximately 5 miles **before** getting to lone Road by **turning left onto Forrest Home Road**.

Continue approximately 1.1 miles then **turn right onto Carbondale Road**.

Continue approximately 3.5 miles then **bare to the left to remain on Carbondale Road**.

Continue approximately 1.9 miles - **Carbondale Road dead ends into Michigan Bar Road. Turn right.**

Continue approximately 0.6 miles then the Gold Country Flying Field **will be on the left**.

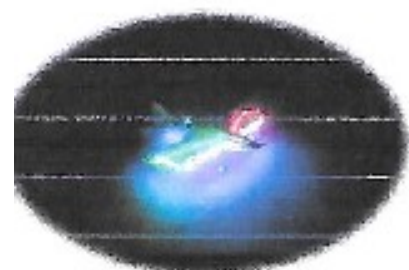

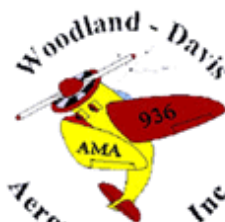
